**Phonics** - We are continuing to work through Phase 2 phonics. We will continue to send home phonics cards, so please use these at home with your children, five minutes practise a day really does make all the difference. Games like: matching pairs, snap or a treasure hunt around the house are a few ways that you can make learning these fun.

**Reading** - Thank you to everyone who has been reading 4 times a week with their child/ren. Reading regularly is crucial for children at this stage of development. We will continue to send a phonics book home every Monday and a phonics comic with the phonic cards on a Friday. We will be sending books home with a bigger variety of words as the children learn more phonic sounds.

Please do continue reading regularly at home, and don't forget to sign your child's diary! We check diaries on a Monday and give dojos for 4 or more reads.

**Maths** – We are really enjoying sharing your photos and videos of your children completing the Tapestry challenge each week. It is a great way of consolidating their learning each week and giving you an insight in to what we are focussing on.

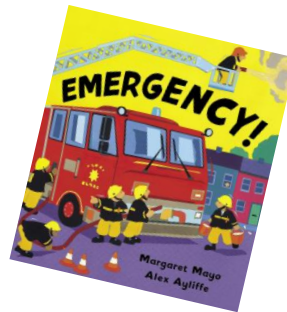
