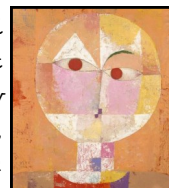




Explorers - Term 2

Term 1 is over! That's gone quick!

In Term 2, the Year 1 children will be continuing to explore the theme "Great Explorers" in their history learning. They will encounter several important historical explorers and will find out about the impact these people have had on the world. The children will also explore how society viewed the roles of men and women differently in the past, and how people's achievements have changed and advanced society for the better. In art, the Year 1 children will discover the work of Paul Klee, exploring paint techniques and colours featured in his works, alongside shapes and positioning. This will lead to a final piece inspired by Klee! The children will also learn about birds in science; the features of birds and how they differ from other animals. They will explore co-operation and managing disagreements in Life Skills, and a Christian parable about forgiveness in R.E. learning.

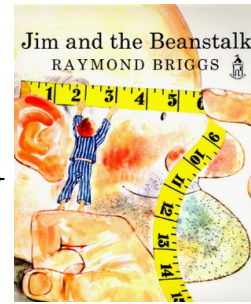
Spellings

This term we will be using the text *Jim and the Beanstalk* by Raymond Briggs to develop story writing skills. Children will explore how to describe settings and add detail into their stories, using similes, conjunctions and adjectives. Later in the term the children will learn instruction writing skills.



Maths

Building on from children's amazing understanding of place value within 10, they will now be learning about place value within 20. This term is all about teen numbers, being able to instantly recognise a teen number and discuss the number of tens and ones within it. Children will be able to fluently count forwards and backwards and count on from any given number.
