- Counting in **2s, 5s and 10s** using everyday objects.
- Talking about **sharing and grouping** when tidying or sharing snacks
- Practising **simple** subtraction within 20
- Measuring objects around the house (length and **height**)
- Noticing and reading the time at o'clock and half **past**
