Remember children get 5 dojos for every 4 reads or more at home!

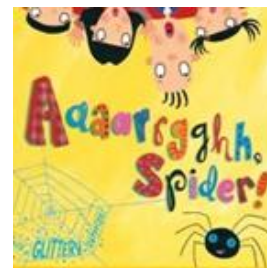
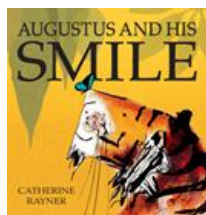

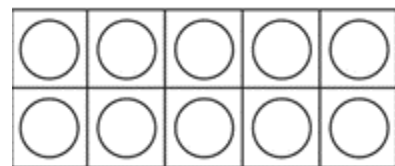
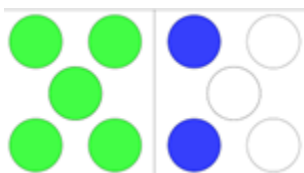


Learning at Pashley
