Knockhatch!



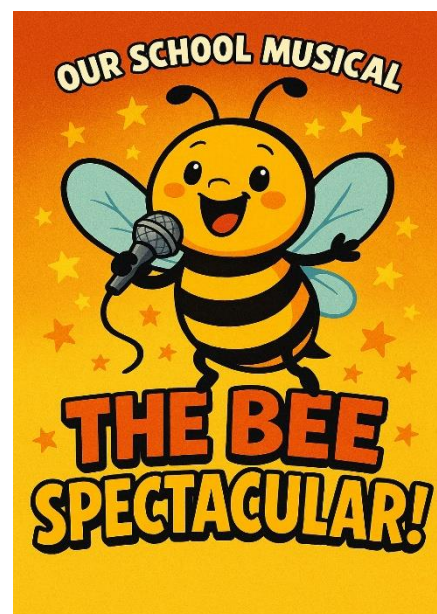

Life skills and values focus of the term

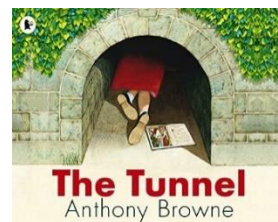
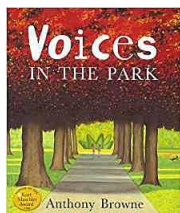
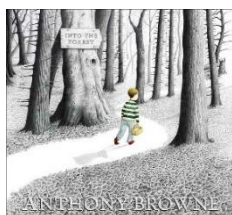
