Who We Provide For

- Children aged **2, 3 and 4**

Session Times

- **Breakfast Club (optional): 7:45am – 8:45am**
- **Core funded day (full-day model): 8:45am – 2:45pm**
- **Extended hours (optional): 2:45pm – 5:00pm**

Our core day aligns closely with the main school day to support families with siblings.

Funded Early Education

We accept:

- **15 hours funding** for eligible 2-, 3- and 4-year-olds
- **30 hours funding** for eligible 3- and 4-year-olds

Funding is delivered within the **core funded day (8:45am–2:45pm)** and claimed in line with Local Authority guidance. Subject to local authority agreement.

Fees

- 2-year-olds: £9.50 per hour
- 3- and 4-year-olds: £8.50 per hour
- Optional Breakfast Club: £7.00 per session
- Optional Hot Lunch: £3.00 per day
- **Voluntary Consumables Contribution: £3.00 per day**

These rates apply to all hours **outside funded entitlement**, including extended provision.

Breakfast Club (Optional)

- **£7.00 per session**
 - Includes breakfast and supervised early provision
 - Must be booked in advance

Funded Hours

Eligible children may access funded early education entitlement hours without purchasing any additional services.

Voluntary Consumables Contribution: £3.00 per day

Parents are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £3.00 per day towards additional consumable items used throughout the pre-school day. This contribution helps support the provision of:

- Healthy snacks and drinks
- Cooking and food-tasting activities
- Enhanced arts, crafts and creative materials
- Gardening and planting resources
- Additional sensory and messy play materials
- Tissues, wipes and other general consumable items used by children

This contribution is voluntary. Children will not be excluded from any activity or receive different treatment if parents choose not to contribute.

Booking Commitment

- **Full-day provision only** (morning-only or afternoon-only sessions are not offered)
 - We strongly recommend families remain with us for a minimum of two terms to support children's wellbeing and learning. Families accessing funded entitlement hours are not required to commit to a minimum attendance period.

- The **core funded day ends at 2:45pm**
- Any care provided after 2:45pm forms part of our extended hours provision and is chargeable
- Fees are payable for all booked sessions, regardless of attendance
- Funding does not cover Breakfast Club, extended hours or optional additional services. Families may choose whether or not to make a voluntary consumables contribution.
